See video present in the tutorial (probably step 9) if all the previous condition are ok (mean symbolic link). What are the parameter that you have provided to define the slave site? See tutorial step 9 that give sample value that should work on any websites. When you create the slave site using a fresh Joomla Installation procedure, ensure that you provide a specific table prefix for the slave site. When you are in the DB Configuration panel where you enter the host, db name, user and password, don't forget to open the Advanced panel to enter the table prefix. It must be different of the master website prefix to avoid replacing the master website but the slave site (The problem that you seems to report). By default, Joomla use jos as table prefix and if your master is also installed with jos, it will be overwritten.
