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This is not clear.

JMS does not change anything concerning the joomla menu.

If I understand correctly you seems mention that when you go in the joomla "menu item manager" to add a new menu entry under joomla 1.5, you see the menu types and when you select a menu type and that you complete the joomla settings after the save, you don't have the menu item created. You use the word "approved" but in joomla 1.5, the word is "published".

If you can provide a screenshot, this will help to confirm the joomla version and that you report an issue with the joomla "menu item manager"

Concerning the rendering of a menu that is correctly published, we suggest that you start by checking the rendering with the standard joomla template.

If the menu is correctly rendered with standard joomla template, that would mean that the issue is relative to the templates that you are using.
