Now I dont want to add slave site as subdomain but as directory is it possible? (abc.com/slave1 and not slave1.abc.com). Yes you can create slave site into a subdirectory like abc.com/slave1

You just have to deploy the slave site into this directory and potential create the directory dynamically.

In manage site put Site ID = slave1 domain = {site url}/{site id} Deploy = {root}/{site id} Create directory = ON

If you want to replicate an existing website, also select a "template site" rule where you have setup the website to replicate.

After making changes of the setting as you suggested. I am getting this message

The site 'slave1' is deployed.

- You can now map your new domain (http://151.108.128.140:22410/slave1) to the directory 'local/apps/rxapi/apache/htdocs/sc17/slave1'.
- When the DNS will be updated with your new domain (perhaps you have to wait 24 hours), you will can go to your new domain and Joomla will request you a new installation (as usual).
- Please use a new db prefix for each site and NEVER use 'jos' as prefix or if you want to keep 'jos' as prefix, create as many databases than you have sites.
