I don't understand your question.
When you create a slave site, it is independent.  Therefore it has its own registration form and store the customers in its own DB table prefix.
In JMS 1.0.x, it is not possible to share the users as this is the case with the new JMS 1.2.x.
As each slave site is independent, you can also install several templates and select different one for each slave site.
Starting with JMS 1.1.x, it is possible to have specific themes (template) directory that would also have different layout.
