
## JMS, multisite for joomla - Joomla Multiple Sites and user sharing

This component is is simply "fantastic".

These are the major sticking points, but if you understand them, then all else you can figure out.

Take the time to read the docs and take advantage of the video tutorials. There's lots of information to wade through but it is worth it.
