However, could you please just clarify if it is possible to install several JReviews on the different sites while still having one Joomla installation using Multisites or if only one install needs to be made? If one install, then how do I create content for each site? Is it at all possible to have a JReviews install together with MultiSites or does the fact that no sharing is allowed mean that I must choose one over the other?

JReview is an extension that is encrypted with IonCube.

So we can not review the code of this extension and therefore discover the data model and see it could be a candidate for the sharing.

If the author does not want to provide us the source of the extension, we can not review it.

In addition, there is a know limitation with JReview concerning the configuration that is shared between all the websites.

So if you install JReview, you will have specific JReview content with each website and also sharing the same configuration. Any modification in the configuration will affect all the websites.
