The sites offer free basic directory listings and paid feature listings. It sounds like there may be an extra fee for some kind of "quota" from JMS? Please provide more information on this - how much is the quota? When is it required?

To contribute to the JMS development, the quota is an additional fee that is request to the person who are creating "billable website" from the front-end. If the JMS is used to sale a service that is specific for websites managed by JMS, we ask an additional fee.

Only the free services are free in JMS.

The price depends on the current quota.

It start with a package of 15 EUR per for 10 websites and go down to reach 300 EUR for 1,000 websites when you already have a quota over 1,000 websites.

So for each website, it starts at 1.5 EUR to go down till 0.30 EUR per site.
