So check the how the "/images" directory is created. Is this a "Symbolic Link" or a "Physical Directory"?

This may explain the reason why you have such problem. If you want to have specific "/images" directory for each website but in the same time share the jomsocial "/images" subdirectory (I don't know the name) then you should have to create a link manually.
