NO suggestion.

The sharing of an extension require to see this extension in interactions without joomla core. If extension require too many thing from the joomla table (because they are linked), I never include this extension as sharing candidate.

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The only extension that can be share are the one that only require to share the joomla users. As soon as an extension require to be linked with something else like the articles, categories, or whatever else, it is not included as shared extensions. This create too many interactions that require to share everything. This is not the objective to have the same content for all the websites.

This is the reason for example that we have created a specific "article sharing for JMS" to provide such flexibility.
