When you create a fresh slave site, normally you don't have any extension pre-installed. See the tutorial video CP-04 that is a sample. http://www.jms2win.com/tutorial#jms12x-CP-04

If you replicate a website that already contain several extension pre-installed, you can either un-install them from the back-end of the slave site OR use the JMS tools menu to un-install the components/modules/plugins that you want. With JMS tools you can also propagate the action to other children websites.
