The problem you will encounter with another reseller account is relative to folder permissions. When you are using different account, the permission will not let you use the symbolic link and create the bdrige between the different domains.

The easiest method consists to "AddOn" a domain an a same account to avoid permission issue.

The concept of JMS is to share the same files and folder on the disk.

So if you are on another account, you will not be able to share the files and folder or this may become difficult to manage the unix group to grant the permission.
