I'm creating a custom PDF exporter for my boss, but there is a problem to generate the PDF, depending on the images path. Relative paths didn't work, so I tried to replace them with the full path, like <http://www.domain.com/images/stories>

it actually worked for images in the master site, but images located at <http://www.domain.com/multisites/slave/images/stories> didn't work. I think the problem may be related to the symbolic links, but I cant figure out what to do next...

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The images that dont work come from the slave sites's "images/stories" folder.

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This peace of code still does not replied to my question.

I have tested the PDF and it works perfectly with the images included normally.  
If you are using Plugin it may be possible that these plugin does not render correctly in a PDF.  
When I have tested with a "Simple Image Gallery", I have retrieved the pattern used to display the images.

When I have used the normal "image" insertion, it works.

So I repeat the question, which kind of images do you put in the articlles.  
Are you using special extension for the images rendering.

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
