With Jms Multisites, you can effectivelly share the VirtueMart extensions and therefore create another websites that will have the same eshop.

In this new wesbite, you will have the same users and will be able to have its own template (look) and create its own articles, menu, ...

So you can have two differents websites with different homepage that will share the same VirtueMart catalog and product.

With Jms multisites, we do NOT syncrhonize anything.

The sharing means that the data are physically present only once.

Therefore, if you physiscally share the VirtueMart, the new websites will be linked to the current one. If later you delete the current one, the new website will lose its data.

If you want to delete the existing website, you will have to replace the MySQL links by a physical copy. JMS will not do that. You will have to do it manuall.
