With Jms Multistites, it is not possible to share partially the users.

If you decide to share the users between lasvegas and newyork this mean that physically, you will have the MySQL table for the users only once in the DB with all the records (the users). This will give the users the possibility to logn on Newyork or Lasvegas.

This will not share the whole DB but only the MySQL tables used by the users (session, access control and users).

I don't know what you mean by send sepecific information to a city. Does that mean create specific articles or send email to all the users present in a websites ?

If you are using NewsLetter application, you can define distribution list. So perhaps this is what you expect to do.
