a) You can share the user with a website site that is not the master. See our tutorial video 16 that show how to share the users between slave1 and slave1A

a fresh Slave site that consist in executing a joomla installation result by the creation of indepedent users..

If you want to share the users, this must be done with a replication of an existing website.

You have to define in the JMS Templates that you want to share the users with the "template site" that you have selected to build the replication rule.
