We have released a Multisites ID version 1.1 plugin that allows you to replace the master ID by something else and also allows adding a dot after the site ID to allow building URLs with site ID in the subdomain like {site_id}.yourdomain.com

Which version of the plugin are you using ?

You have to check that you have perfectly spelled the keyword.

This is an exact match.

In version 1.1, you can also create variant for the :master_db: and replace by a special value like "www".

So it should work but check the html generate to ensure there is no special character that could make the exact match fail.

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
