- 1. Slave sites can display selected content articles from the master site.
- 2. SOBI2 can be installed on the master site and all slaves can display/search SOBI2 contents
- 3. Articles can be added to each slave site and not be viewed on other slave sites or master site
- 4. Each site can be installed with it's own database and Joomla files independent from master site
- 5. Each slave can have it's own template
- 6. Certain components can be shared from master to slave
