The procedure to share the extension between different DB is the same as tutorial video 16 except the fact that you have to provide different DB and that the MySQL User that you will use to share the extension has enought MySQL privileges to do that.

This latest part that consists to use a MySQL user privileges with enought permission is the key element that is not necessary provided by shared hosting.

So if you have a dedidcated server or at least have the MySQL user root login to access the PHPMyAdmin "privileges" menu then you should be able to manage the MySQL user privilegest to provide the permission between the different DBs.

The simpliest method is to use the root MySQL user that by definition has all the privileges.
