

Not yet compatible with PHP 5?

Hey there,

I was wondering, why I (sometimes) get a white screen, when using Multisite. Somewhere in the forum, it says that it's probably a php parsing error, so I turned on error logging. And I got the following error:

03 Dec 2010 15:40:41, "/homepages/29/d133797749/htdocs/multisite_master/configuration.php: 7", "() Non-static method Jms2Win::matchSlaveSite() should not be called statically"

When I fixed it, by declaring it a static function I got the next error:

03 Dec 2010 15:52:31, "/homepages/29/d133797749/htdocs/multisite_master/includes/multisites.php: 414", "() Non-static method Jms2Win::__getCurrentURL() should not be called statically"

This could probably go on for a while, since the whole code is still PHP 4.

What really bugs me, is that this error does not always result in a white page. It seems like (it sounds crazy) different slave sites react differently to this error. I know that this does not make sense.

The "non static" message are warning that can not create a white page.

White page can be resulting of a FATAL error and not from a warning.

If you have a white page and running under cPanel, you perhaps have a "error_log" file that would provide more info on the fatal error and the source that generate this fatal error.

As you seems have a log with "warning", I suppose you can have a look if you have a fatal error somewhere.

You may have 2 error_log file. One in the root and another one in the '/administrator' directory.
