Sorry but your description is not clear or inconsistent.

You mentioned that you want to have the CRM running in a wrapper within the site and after you ask how to auto create a CRM for each website.

If you are using a wrapper, this means that the CRM is present in a single website and that all wrappers call this website to have access to the common CRM. So that they don't have a duplicated CRM.

The idea is to have a website that contains the CRM (ie crmsite) and another website with the articles and content (ie. contentsite) that contains a wrapper on your CRM website. So that you can replicate the "contentsite" to build the children website for the consultant and that is ready to use.

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
