Good night, it seems that this time if the component works correctly, I created 3 sub-domain and load well, albeit a little slow.

- Now, I ask them how to achieve the following: I want to create 23 sub-domain (the domain would be 24 website), and that these subdomains have as my home page the same page of the domain, but with thin changes as the logo and IPorperty a component modules.
- Look at the web is unaimobiliaria and each subdomain to display it on their homepage according to homes subdomain. If, for example, enter the subdomain peru.dominio.com showing homes in this country, if you get one loaded mexico.dominio.com homes in this country as a home page and so on.
- I want to show on each subdomain an advanced search box housing for Caada different subdomain, if someone accesses for example, the domain chile.dominio.com the advanced search box has just loaded the provinces of Chile, and so the other, a pronicias search box by each country according to the subdomain accessed.
- You do not want to have 23 different Joomla installations, if not in this one and make all necessary settings.
- I also want that when any user agent or log into a subdomain or domain, the session is initiated for all subdomains.
- And finally hope that when an agent add a home for sale or rent, this may appear in all subdomains if any user does a search from the parent domain.

I can do all these actions with multi component site? Can you give me a hint on how I can do?

Create 23 slave site is possible.

If you want to share the same front page, between all the websites, this is possible with the "Article Sharing for JMS".

Concerning the logo, you have different solutions that depends on the Joomla template that you are using.

So templates have the logo specified by a custom HTML module. So in this case, you have to change the custom HTML in each slave.

Other templates give the possibility to configure the templates by a parameter.

Other are using a class hardcoded in the CSS. In this case, you can change the path present in the CSS to give a new location that is specific for each slave site.

- Concerning the search, this is not clear.

We have a "Multisites Search plugin" that allows you select in each slave site which are the sites that

must be scanned for the sections, categories and articles (in case of Joomla 1.6 - categories and articles).

- If you clone an existing website, you don't need the "Joomla installer".

but when I speak, via cute ftp manager, to /public_html/multisite/ directories are created with the name of

subdomain and within these directories is a complete system copied from the master joomla. It seems that the JMS Multisite copied the whole directory /public_html/ to sub-directory /public_html/ multisite/.

What does this mean?
