The key element is to create a JMS template rule where you mention the action "copy" for thetemplates" directory. This will replicate the website with a specific "/templates" directory.
If you have a "blank screen" or "blank page" you have to check you error log file because this is the symptom of a PHP fatal error somewhere.
If you share the "whole site", this is also possible to have a specific "/templates" directory but in this case you can not change the selected template. Everything will be shared except the "/templates" directory on the disk. As you will have a specific "/templates" directory, you can replace any files inside this directory and customize your template for the website.

Perhaps you could use the hello world procedure in tutorial video 7 to check the server setting.

If you have a .htaccess present, perhaps there is a "rewritebase" active with a wrong value.
