But when using the template as default in front end i got this message "The template for this display is not available. Please contact a Site administrator."

From what i see today in my ftp client the template folder is a shortcut of the master template folder.

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If you want to re-install a template from the slave site, you have to either setup the action with "copy" or "special copy" and use in the JMS Template common tabs the "template folder" = {deploy\_dir}/templates like illustrated in the tutorial video 0.d slide 34

This will give you the possibility to go in the back-end extension manager of the slave site and install the "joomla template" in the slave site.

Perhaps that you have different ownership of the files and folders.

So check the permission of the target directory to verify that you have the permission to write into this directory.

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
