1) To install the "Multisites Menu Item" into the slave site, you can use the JMS Tool menu and just

select the "install" action in the slave site and click on the "execute" button.

If you want to replace existing menu item with the "multisites menu item", you have to rebuild them.

2) Concerning the sharing the "/templates" directory, check the "JMS Template rule" that you created to build the slave site and verify that you have select the "special copy" action for the "/templates" directory.
