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I just installed/upgraded JCE editor on the JMS master and used TOOLS to populate and overwrite children. JCE works in the Master installation but the when I go to a slave site to edit an article I get the error message: "Call to undefined method stdClass::onDisplay() in /home/\*\*\*/domains/\*\*\*/com/subdomains/master/public\_html/libraries/joomla/html/editor.php on line 268" (\*\* = my website). Does that mean the slaves can't find the JCE editor? How can I fix?

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I suspect that a JCE plugin is missing in the slave site.  
Perhaps there is new plugins to install in the slave site and that are not yet installed.

I suggest that you uninstall the JCE in the slave site and that you re-install it.
