Share a whole website mean that you use the same DB with the same table prefix for the different website. As this is the same DB for the webiste, this also mean that the default joomla template is the same. You can not change the default template as this is an information that is stored in the DB.
As the joomla templates are saved on the disk into the /templates directory, the only thing that you can do is to put other files into a directory that have a same name.

When replacing the content of this directory with the content of another template, this will be the new template that is used.

So if you rename the "beez" into "ja_purity", you get the beez template.
