Doesn't view anywhere in the site though.
I've never had this issue before and wonder if there's something gone wrong with this slave in the creation process? It might not be multisite issue at allit's just my initial line of enquiry!

All I can suggest is to verify step by step where the images is store when you upload it and after verify the HTML source generated to verify the link to the images file.
I suppose that you use the Joomla image manager to upload the image. Which joomla version do you use ?
After that you have uploaded the images, it is stored in the correct /images/ directory
Varify also if you above the /images directory or if you beyon a sife /images directory for each alove site

Verify also if you share the /images directory or if you have specific /images directory for each slave site.

Does the /images directory in the slave site is a Symbolic Link or a copy of the master /images
