This class should exists.
Otherwise you would get a fatal error to read the file

/xxx/xxx/xx/xx/xxxxxxx/htdocs/aa-master/administrator/components/com_multisites/libraries/joomla/filesystem/jms2winfile.php

So verify that this file is present and has a content.

As you didn't reported a fatal error to include the file, I can just imagine that is correctly included and therefore that the class is present.

Otherwise, the file should not be included and you would get another fatal error prior this one.
