

## Slave site set up in folder now required as main

My client has an existing non-JMS Joomla installation on [www.clientdomain.com](http://www.clientdomain.com)

Client then required a number of sites with the ability to pass information to each other so I suggested JMS.

I then set up [master.clientdomain.com](http://master.clientdomain.com) as the master and a slave on [master.clientdomain.com/secondsite](http://master.clientdomain.com/secondsite) as a secondary site that would operate as a folder off the main site.

The client now wants the slave site built on [master.clientdomain.com/secondsite](http://master.clientdomain.com/secondsite) to be the main site, i.e. [www.clientdomain.com](http://www.clientdomain.com).

Should I now map [www.clientdomain.com](http://www.clientdomain.com) to [master.clientdomain.com/secondsite](http://master.clientdomain.com/secondsite)?

I know that for an add-on domain, I would have to map the domain name to the folder in cPanel but how do I handle the JMS configuration if it's not an add-on domain but the main domain?

Yes, if you don't want to move the existing slave sites subdirectory into another place for the [clientdomain](http://clientdomain) you have to effectively map the domain to the location of the master.

Remark:

If the [master.clientdomain.com](http://master.clientdomain.com) is a public website, search engine might also discover the subdirectory and give a ranking penalty in case of duplicate content.

So if "[master.clientdomain.com](http://master.clientdomain.com)" is private and not public, this is not a problem. Otherwise, you should consider moving the subdirectory into another place for the [www.clientdomain.com](http://www.clientdomain.com)

See also our tutorial video 0.b slide 21-24 that give recommendation concerning the architecture and directory structure to ensure that subdomain and domain always have specific unique directory
