All I see is that when you enable your administrator template, there are bugs in javascript of this template that may disturb the javascript used by JMS to refresh data upon screen.µ

Perhaps also that the problem comes from GoogleGears because the javascript error concern a variable

Create a DB dynamically is only possible if the MySQL user that you have provided in your master DB or in the multisites.cfg.php file has enough privileges.

If you are working with a hosting provider, may be you have to create the DB with the hosting server interface like cPanel before using it into a website.

When the DB does not exists, JMS try to create one using the MySQL login defined in multisites.cfg.php file see User Manual page 14.

If there is no "root" MySQL user provided in the multisites.cfg.php file, it uses the MySQL login and

password that is present in the website to replicate (here in your case the master\_db or slave1 DB ).

If those user have not enough privileges to create a new DB, this will return the kind of error message that you have mentionned.

I don't understand your reply with the 755 permission to the multisites.cfg.php.

I don't know if this is the file itself to which you give the permission or if this is in the content of this file that contain a variable with 0755.

If this is the variable, I don't understand because the default value is already 0755.

You have to check in the directory associated to the url <http://eportaltwo.printreplica.com> the files themselves.

Normally, you should have an index.php files with something inside and not a zero size length.

Perhaps again you have permission issue to access some directories or files that may explain your blank page.

If this is a test websites I suggest that you put a chmod 777 recursively on all your websites to verify this

hypothesis.

I suspect that you have problem with owner or group of file that are not unique for all your website and that may does not give your website access all the files.
