Sharing "Alpha User Point" share Alpha User Point + Joomla Users; Sharing "VirtueMart" shares "virtuemart" + Joomla Users;
I don't see why you mention Community Builder because I don't see relationship with the other two extensions.
As you have not provided the MySQL error I can just imagine that they correspond to a MySQL permission error like "command denied to user".
If this is the case, you have to check the MySQL user privileges when sharing the extensiions.  It is required that MySQL user has the privilege to create and show views.
