The DB parameters that you see in the manage site "list" is the one that come from the "configuration.php" file of each website.

This is the current "active" value of the website.

When you edit a website, the "new xxxx" fields show the value that you have entered or computed the previous time to create the slave site.

If they are different, this perhaps mean that you changed the configuration.php file outside JMS that is possible when you go in the "global configuration" of the slave sites or when you modify the "configuration.php" file manually.
