You have to create a JMS template rule to replicate the first slave and create the second one.

Get inspired on the tutorial video 13

That show a similar process to replicate a "tpl_master" from the front-end.

Create a JMS template that would be

Template ID = replic_XXX

Select the template site XXX

Put a new table prefix = {site_id}_

Once you have the rules defined, you can use it to create the YYY slave site.

Site ID = yyy

Domain = yyy.com

Select the "replic xxx" template rule.

Put the new DB name that you probably have to create before with PYPMyAdmin or other admin tool.

Put the deploy directory /www/yyy
