Check that you are correctly setup the slave site definition.

If you have deployed the slave site into a specific directory (that is normally the case for domain or subdomain with Plesk), put different site name title in the "configuration.php" file to ensure that you can login with different title in your website.

If your slave site display the title of your master, you have to cross-check that JMS Manage site definition to ensure that you have correctly spelled the domain name or subdomain name. Check for example that you have defined the domain with and without the WWW.
