Just tried to update to the latest version and I saw that the recommended procedure involves uninstalling the patches first. I did just that, accessed the back-end and uninstalled the patches and then BOOM this is the error I get -

Won't go away no matter how I try to access the site - Thankfully, I did backup the site prior to this, but is there a more efficient way to restore site functionality?

The potential reason why you have this error is that you have changed the table prefix or the DB name corresponding to your master website.

As you could read in another reply in this forum, when you uninstall the patches, this restore the original "configuration.php" file that was present when you have install the patches the first time. So if you changed the DB connection, this restore an older one that seems does not exists anymore.
