What is the configuration to manage handling of parked domains.

I've updated the A Record to point to the host server

I've updated my apache with
ServerAlias parkeddomain1.tld parkeddomain2.tld

I've updated the Slave Site Domains with
www.parkeddomain1.tld
www.parkeddomain2.tld

But when I try parkeddomain1.tld and parkeddomain2.tld all I get is an Index of / page from apache.

In general the parked domain are attached to a primary domain.

So if you have assign yourself the ServerAlias, verify the the document root correspond to your master website directory.

See the concept presented in the tutorial video 0.b slide 10.

Parked domain is a solution to share the same master website directory but you will not be able to have specific images and templates directory (most of extension may have hardcoded these names).
