The "Article Sharing for JMS" is an extension that directly read the articles in foreign DB.  
JoomFish is an extension that only provide the translation for current websites and it does not exists in "Multisites" version.  
So JoomFish, is not able to know the articles present in the other website and is not able to provide any translation for these articles.

If you decide to have articles in several language, you will have to create articles for each languages and provide the appropriate reference to the article in a specific language. In this case, you can not use JoomFish to have the "shared" article present in different languages.
