Good evening, watch a few moments subdomains probe had already created and that worked very well, did not work, not load. The web browser could not display the webpage.

What I did was add physical subdomains in the administration panel of the web server: fierce, and probe the subdomains and I got a 403 error and a message saying that I have no permission to enter that directory.

I went back to delete the subdomains in the administration panel Fierce and try again, and at that time if charged subdomains. So, I create and delete subdomains in the administration panel and delete to work. or what?
