What has failed ?

I see that you ask to create a new website into a new db using the {site\_id}.

Did you use a MySQL root user to allow creating DB dynamically or did you create the DB before running the rule ?

Perhaps you could start to build the website into the same DB (here the master DB one) to identify the parameter that does not work.

Do you want to create the website from the front-end or from the back-end.

In case of the front-end, the {site\_id} parameter is not filled and is computed with the "to site id" field.

The key element concerning the domain.com/{site\_id} is the location on the disk that seems correctly located in {root}/{site\_id}. This seems correct.
