First the message is a "Notice" that just report that Joomla try to access a field that does not exists.

If you want to remove this "notice" message, you have to add a test in joomla (not in JMS) to verify that the field exists before trying to get its value.

This peace of code is processed by Joomla when it suppose runing on IIS environment.

Which Joomla version and which language are you using ?

If you want to be sure that you are using the same "Joomla Installation" directory of your Joomla then you can restore the installation directory from your own Joomla zip (or tar.gz) distribution. Jms will patch your "/installation" directory instead of restoring one from a Joomla zip file.

Perhaps this will fix your problem.

On which kind of server are you running ?

This warning is a Joomla warning message and not a JMS one.

If you want to ignore this warning message, you can add a test to verify that "QUERY_STRING" exists but I am not convinced this will solve your problem as this is a warning message and not a fatal error.

Perhaps you could have a look in Joomla bug tracker to see if you have info concerning this case.
