You can test if the symbolic link are available with the tutorial video 7 (hello world). Symbolic Link is something available on Linux platform and may depends on the server settings that may or may not autorize using symbolic links.

The concept of JMS Multisites is based on the sharing of the joomla installation (php code). So I don't recommend to perform a copy of the joomla directories except the images and templates directories that may have to be customized by users.
