If you are using apache, perhaps you have a error log file that provide more info on the reason of the bank screen.

Perhaps you simply have a permission error to access a file or a directory.

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In general the entry point is "index.php".

If you don't find the "error log" file, contact the administrator of your server to ask him the reason. It should be written in a log file that perhaps you don't have.

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There is no index.php file in the multisites/members directory, there are 3 files, index.html (which contains 1 line with a background color), cache, and config\_multisites.php.

Also, I am running this in a private apache virtual machine under vmware so I do not need to go to a server admin to make changes.
