If it is not present in the list, perhaps they have change the name of the extension on the disk. In this case, if you think that the front page slide show is changed, you can send us the extension in the attachement of an email.

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Patches can not be applied manually.

The FPSS 3.1 that you send us had some issue to be installed on a normal Joomla 1.5. It seems that it require engine=InnoDB to make it works.

Beside that, we installed it on Joomla 1.5.25 and the extension didn't changed of name. It is still the "com\_fpss" and correctly appear in the JMS tool extension.

Perhaps you have to check that you are using the latest JMS version and that you have the definition of the "FPSS".

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Why do you need a patch for the "com\_fpss".

This extension now save the configuration (option button) in the DB and no more in a file on the disk. So there is no more need a patch for this extension.

This "com\_fpss", save the images in the directory /media/com\_fpss. So if you want to have specific media directory, change the JMS Template rule to "copy" the media directory instead of sharing it (symbolic link).
