Verify your cPanel or other admin tool that you subdomain is correctly assigned to the master website directory.

Use for example the "hello world" to verify that the subdomain is correctly defined in your apache or IIS. See tutorial video 7 for the hello world.

Once you validated the HTTP Server configuration, verify the url that you specified. Some hosting provider add a "WWW" in front of the subdomain.

To have the correct website display, it is required to have an exact matching between the URL and the domain that you have entered in the slave site. This is case sensitive.

Do not use HTTP Server redirection that modify the URL value.

So verify that you spelled the domain name correctly.

Did you get a success when you have saved the slave site definition.

You need to have a success "blue message" to have the slave site correctly defined.
