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Can you give a clear copy of the configuration file.

Your server mentioned a syntax error in line 3 but this screenshot does not help identifying which is the line no 3

Do you have specifial character present in your site name or other special character at other place.

You have a backup of the original file that is saved in the  
/administrator/components/com\_multisites/backup directory.

In addition, you mentioned that you are using Joomla 2.5 and I suspect that you are not using the latest JMS version 1.2.86.

You need at least JMS 1.2.82 to be compatible with Joomla 2.5.4
