Hi,

I have installed JMS in my site, and installed the patch. Then, when I tried to log into the Arrowchat admin (mysite/arrowchat/admin), I got 404 error. It automatically redirects to /arrowchat/admin/installation/index.php, which does not exist. I uninstalled the patches, and the admin panel works as usual.

So, I'm thinking that one of the patches thinks that the arrowchat/admin folder (or any non-Joomla folder in the root folder, I suspect) is somehow a not-yet-installed Joomla site.. Can I maybe exclude the arrowchat folder or something?
