If I manually try to uninstall it, I get the error * Plugin Uninstall: Manifest File invalid or not found Message * Uninstall Plugin Error If I then re-install SH404SEF on the slave site I then have 2 plugins. The earlier one may now be uninstalled. Regards Tim

If you have an error on the manifest, this probably mean that it is not present also on the master website.

When you un-install an extension from the slave site, this only remove the definition of this extension in the DB and this NOT remove the files on the disk as they are need by the master website or other slave site.
