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The column sharing mean that you can share this extension between several websites.

For example you have the possibility to share the joomla user but also extension like jomsocial, jevent, community builder, kunena forum, ...

Sharing at the different of "synchronized" extension mean that you really share data. On other words that you have a single instance of the data. There is no replication and no duplication of the data between different website as when you share you have the access to the single information correspondant to this extension.

In the case of users, this mean that the data are store in a single place. The place is the one where you have decided to create the users. The other website just use link to connect on this user table.

This is like a shortcut in windows that allows you access to physical information present in another place. The information is present only once and the others are links.

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
