Any suggestions?

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You have to update the VM Configuration to change the "security" parameter and the URL used by the slave site.

You have 2 URLs, one for site URL and second for seured URL.

By default when you have never save the VM configuration, JMS read the default one (master) and therefore retrieve the master URL.

Where and how can I update the slave configuration?

All VM tables were linked to the master db at time of slave creation

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NO, unfortunately, VM does not save the configuration into the DB and therefore is NOT shared.  
This is the reason why I told you to go in the VM back-end and in its configuration.

You have to change the security tabs in the VM configuration.  
The URL to access the VM back-end configuration is like  
index.php?pshop\_mode=admin&page=admin.show\_cfg&option=com\_virtuemart

So go in VM and select their menu configuration.

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There is something very wierd going on with my slave installation

The backend of the slave works fine. no problem there  
However when I open VM in the backend teh links to the products, admin etc is  
.com/administrator/ .....

Yet when I open this in the master the links show  
.com/www/administrator/...

Any idea why this subdirectory www is removed in the VM backend of the slave?  
Other menu items (outside VM) point nicely to the www

I am lost now...

I now have set the site and security url to point to the slave.  
When I press add to cart it still jumps to the master site

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I don't see how it can jump to another domain except if you have not defined the name correctly in JMS.

Check that the link used by the VM Add button is correctly produced.  
(It should use the URL that you have specified in the VM configuration).

If it is correct as I expect, you have later to check that you domain is correctly spelled in JMS and that you have for example defined the domain with both WWW and without the WWW.

When a domain is not defined in JMS, it automatically display the default one (the master).

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Thanks...  
I am getting closer

The slave config file contains  
`define( 'URL', 'http://www.metamedicine.com/www/' );`  
`define( 'SECUREURL', 'http://www.metamedicine.com/www/' );`

yet in the slave admin it mentions:  
`/administrator/components/com_virtuemart/virtuemart.cfg.php :: Writeable (=master)`

yet the images and the add button still point to the master

in master jms setting:  
`deploy: /var/www/metamedicine_com/www/`  
`domainnames http://www.metamedicine.com (tried also http://www.metamedicine.com/www/)`

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When I edit the VM main config into

```
echo "---:".MULTISITES_ID;  
if ( defined( 'MULTISITES_ID' ) && file_exists( dirname(__FILE__) .DS. 'virtuemart.' .MULTISITES_ID.  
' .cfg.php' ) ) {
```

and then the slave shows

----: MULTISITES\_ID

Indicating that MULTISITES\_ID is not defined

Any suggestions?

Sorry, but I don't see.

If you have correctly installed the JMS patches and the URL are correctly defined then I don't see the origin.

Normally VM use the field URL or SECUREURL to compute the link.  
So the link should be OK except if you don't have installed the JMS patches.

In response to

echo "----:".MULTISITES\_ID; in my basic VM config I get the following results

In the backend of my slave it shows the correct ID

---:metamedicine\_commmcfg

In the frontend of my slave

---:MULTISITES\_ID

I have installed the latest version and incl all patches are OK

Joomla Multi Sites version: 1.2.10 (Latest available: 1.2.10)

Patches definition version: 1.2.13 (Latest available: 1.2.13)

It looks like the VM patch does not load the MULTISITES\_ID in the frontend  
(but it does it correctly on the backend)

Where is this code that handles the setting of this define in the frontend ?

JMS Master config looks ok

Domain names: <http://www.metamedicine.com>

deploy : /var/www/metamedicine\_com/www/

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When I add

```

To the Joomla site config in the slave, then the add button redirects correctly to metamedicine.com  
However, then the images are not shown.

Please advise, as I am getting frustrated with this component

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The define MULTISITES is automatically computed by JMS when you are displaying the correct websites.  
So if you see the correct content, this means that it is defined.  
So you don't have to add it twice.

If the JMS patch for the VM Configuration wrapper is correctly installed in the master, you should read  
the correct VM config file.

So it seems that you have patches not installed or I don't know the reason.

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The Multisites ID is computed at the beginning of the processing before Joomla start.

Normally, if the VM virtuemart.cfg.php is called directly (that normally is not the case), it contain a wrapper that allow to call JMS to compute the multisites id.

This is a complex algorithm that I don't want to develop here.

In summary, if the correct website is displayed, this means that multisites id is defined because this is it that trigger the dispaly of the correct webpage.

If your add button has not the correct URL then I don't know the reason.

You have ordered JMS on [www.jms2win.com](http://www.jms2win.com) that use VirtueMart and you had any problem with the URL. It uses exactly the same code.

So the problem is somewhere else and I don't know where.

The only solution is to debug your specific environment.

Based on your trace, it seems that the administrator/components/com\_virtuemart/virtuemart.cfg.php is correctly installed. So I don't know why.

Perhaps you are using a specific themes (templates) that would bypass everything. I don't know.
