The plugin on each site references different folders inside of their respective slave site folder for the location of the images to be used. However if my sites are accessed simultaneously it is possible for one site to show another sites images.

I just ran across this issue on my site. The problem is how your playlists are being saved. Remember this is symlinks so the playlists are being saves back at the main site. You need to be sure that each sites saves it's playlists as a separate file. Although I wasn't using the same Image module as you, but the issue is the same.

Concerning this extension, we are not able to read the code as the loader is a flash application for which we don't have the sources published by the author.

All we can tell you is that the extension save some parameters in file /jsn_imageshow_pro/xmldata{number }.xml where the number is the module ID attributed by Joomla.

As the xmldata is saved in the same "/modules" directory for all the website, it may happen that you have 2 websites that use the same module ID for this module. In this case, you could modify the value used but the other website.

If you suspect that the URL is wrong inside the module, you can also edit the XML file and perhaps fix the URL to reflect the correct website.

Perhaps you could report such kind of problem to the author of the JSON imageshow.

As was stated the playlist is created automatically when the rotator starts running. The problem is the file that is generated is always the same name as well as the path due to the symlinks.

What I did was to include the site_id in the file name so that each site created different filenames I am using the following:

```
$f = fopen(dirname(__FILE__) . '/core/playlist' . $this->modid . '.xml','w');
```

In this case the modid would be equal to the site_id.
